Our Watercolour painting courses run from Monday to Friday with the expert tuition of a professional Art teacher. We have a wealth of subjects here – for example flowers, old buildings, farmhouse and buildings, beautiful views, the river, bridge, pond, etc., etc. The 'Millennium Studio', from which there are lovely views, provides a studio base and undercover facilities should the weather be inclement.



## ABOUT OUR TUTOR

Kevin Middleton is an experienced art teacher who travels across the country giving demonstrations and course instruction.

Kevin's approach is entirely flexible, catering for a mixed group of abilities so whether you are a beginner or an experienced artist he will ensure you gain the maximum benefit from his teaching. Kevin's love is watercolours but he will also show you (time permitting) how to use other media such as pencil drawing, and pen and ink.

## WHAT YOU WILL NEED

Watercolour Course:

You will need the following equipment:-

- Selection of B pencils
- Good quality plastic eraser (not a putty rubber)
- At least two drawing boards, either MDF or plywood of not less than A3 size
- A sharp craft knife or scalpel
- Brown gummed tape 1" wide (for stretching your paper)
- Generous water pot
- Kitchen roll
- Portable stool or chair to use outside
- Watercolour paper – Saunders, Waterford, Bockingford or Arches. You will need at least two A4 size pieces per day
- No's 3, 6 and 8 sable brushes (or similar)
- A wash brush (1" brush from a DIY shop)
- A small sketchbook, approximately A5 size
- Folding paint pallet
- Paint - Artists quality paints (rather than student quality) are far superior in every way and are worth the extra cost. You will need the following colours:  
**Transparent Yellow or Lemon Yellow**  
**Raw Sienna**  
**Burnt Sienna**  
**Permanent Magenta**  
**Ultramarine Blue (green shade)**  
**Windsor Blue or Phtalo Blue (red shade)**  
 Other suggested colours (but not essential) could be  
 Gamboge Hue or Cadmium Yellow  
 Cadmium Red or Windsor Red  
 Permanent Rose  
 Cobalt Blue  
 Cobalt Violet

All this equipment can be obtained from your local art shop or on-line or mail order through Jacksons ([www.jacksonsart.co.uk](http://www.jacksonsart.co.uk))  
 If you have a digital camera this may be useful and we can print off photographs should the weather be wet. Please wear appropriate shoes and clothes as you will be outside as much as the weather will allow.
